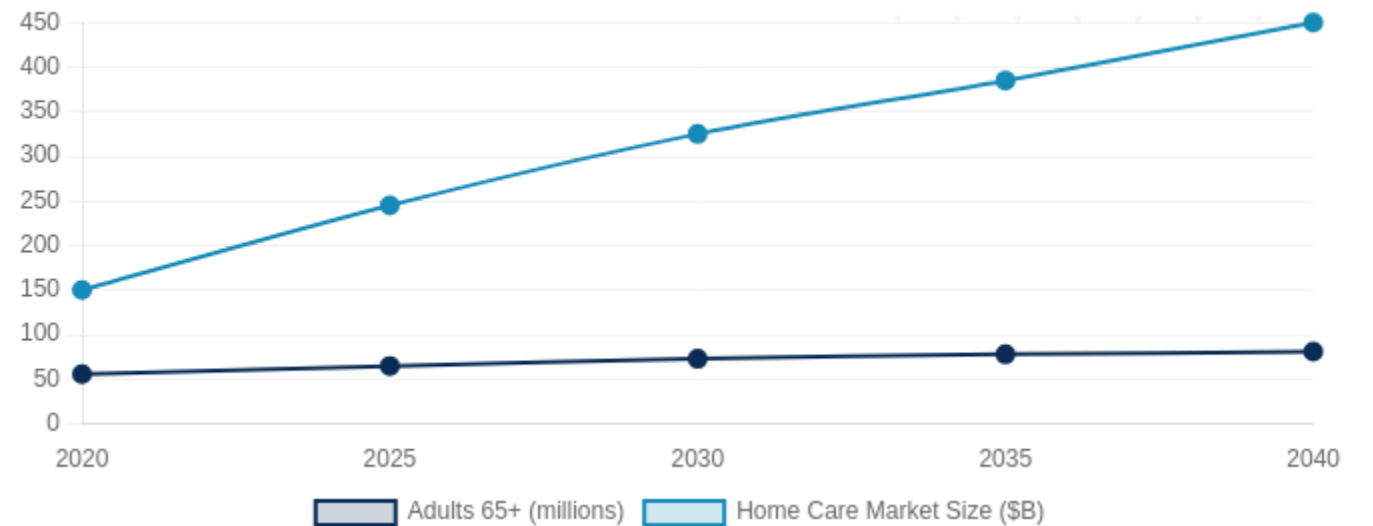

## Caregiver Shortages

The demand for caregivers is dramatically outpacing supply, creating service gaps and increasing costs. Traditional hiring and staffing models are failing to meet the growing needs of an aging population.

**Projected shortage by 2025:** 450,000 caregivers



## Fragmented Care Coordination

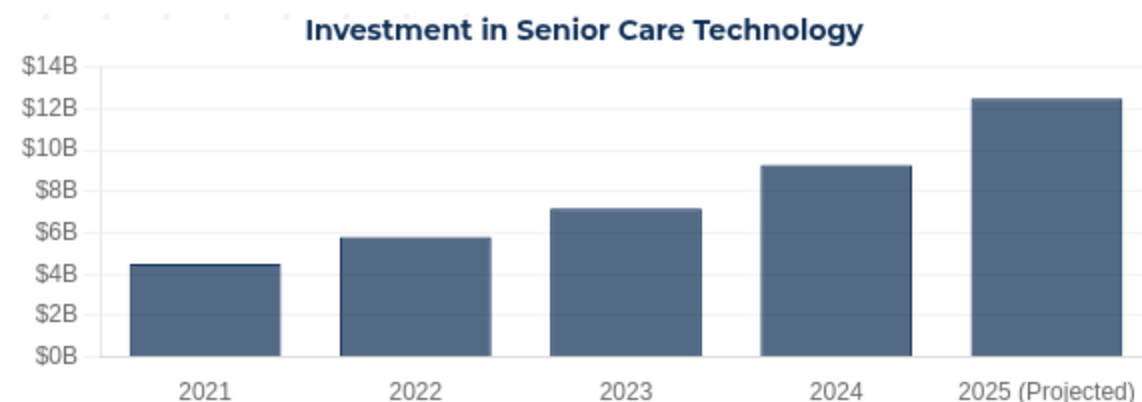
